On 18th of February 2020 Office of the Alumni Affairs, P.E.S College of Engineering organised a webinar on National Education Policy 2020, Titled Moving towards Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education in Higher Education Institutions. The Keynote speaker Prof. Kalpana Subbaramappa, Alumni from the batch of 1995, EEE, currently working as Project Manager, Machine Intelligence and Robotics Centre of Excellence (MINRO) in the International Institute of Information Technology, Bangalore delivered the hour-long session.


The Webinar was flagged of by Dr.H. V Ravindra, Principal, P.E.S College of Engineering and P.E.T President Shri K.S Vijay Anand. Dr.B. Dinesh Prabhu, TEQIP Coordinator, Dr.H.M Sanjay, Head of Alumni Affairs and Mr. Ullas.P, Faculty coordinator of Alumni Affairs were present during the occasion.

The session started with Mr.Ullas P welcoming the virtual participants and introducing the guest speaker. During her talk Prof. Kalpana Subbaramappa spoke about the Rigid boundaries in the present-day education systems and explained how it only leads to unidimensional personality development. She spoke about the Tradition of multidisciplinary learning that existed in ancient and quoted Bhanabhatta's work on 64 arts. Speaking about the need of Holistic learning she visited the challenges that the industries face when its members have only subject relevance but lack field knowledge which is very much required for the present-day survival. Also, she spoke about the transitions that are happening in the industry. Later, talking about the National Education policy 2020 she emphasised the need of imaginative and flexible curriculum structures that are needed to be put in place. She concluded by speaking about the need of Challenging oneself and need for breaking boundaries. She also emphasised the need of creating educational techniques & technology pertinent to Indian subcontinent.

The session ended with a Q&A session and later a feed back form was circulated to all the participants via google forms. The response chart is attached below.
