It was resolved to confirm the proceedings of the previous BOG meeting held on 27/06/2020.

Dr. H V Ravindra, Principal, & Director, TEQIP-III, briefed the action taken on the proceedings of the previous BOG meeting held on 27/06/2020. After discussion, it was unanimously resolved to approve the same.

4.1. Submission of Statutory Audit Report for the year 2019-20 to NPIU & SPIU.

Resolved to approve the Statutory Audit report conducted by M/s CGS & Co., Chartered Accountants, Bengaluru which has been sent to NPIU, MHRD, New Delhi and SPIU, Karnataka, as per the procedure set by NPIU.

4.2. Submission of Internal Audit Report for the First & Second Quarter of financial year 2020-21 (April to September 2020)

Resolved to approve the Internal Audit report conducted by M/s Srinath and Anoop, Chartered Accountants, Bengaluru which has been sent to NPIU, MHRD, New Delhi and SPIU, Karnataka, as per the procedure set by NPIU.

4.3. Initiation of Extending financial support for Start-up activities of Bio Fuel Centre

Resolved to approve Extending financial support for Start-up activities of Bio Fuel Centre for the intended estimated electrical work [An estimation of Rs. 1,47,000/- has been given by the Civil Works Nodal officer of TEQIP-III, to start up the work.] and also the appropriation of expenditure in the ratio of 50:50 by the College and TEQIP-III(IRG)

4.4. Approval of estimate for Extension of Bio fuel centre for start-up activities

Resolved to approve the Extension of Bio fuel centre for start-up activities for the intended estimated civil/electrical works [An estimate for Rs7.25 lakhs for the extension of Bio Fuel Centre for start-up activities has been prepared by the Nodal officer-Civil Works TEQIP-III]. The Principal informed the august body that the expenditure will be met out from TEQIP-III grants after the installation of new software / GEM Portal subject to the approval of BOG.

Honorable member, Prof.(Dr.) D.K Subramanian appreciated the intension, effort and implementation.

4.5. Delay in procurement process.

The August body expressed its satisfaction for the efforts taken to initiate GEM process.

Implementation of GEM registration process has been successfully carried out at our institution by creation of Primary and Secondary users. The ID and passwords for both Primary & Secondary users has been allocated by Special Officer, e-governance, Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of Karnataka in GEM platform.



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Further, Honorable member Prof. Manohar G Nayak brought to the notice of the august body that, at present, GEM process was initiated & succeeded in its implementation for TEQIP institutions of Karnataka state only. This was possible by repeated efforts of Principal Secretary, Commissioner of Dept. of H.E., Commissioner of Collegiate, Director, and Directorate of Technical Education and office of SPIU unit, Karnataka state.

4.6. Nomination of New Nodal Officer - Finance for TEQIP-III

Resolved to approve the nomination of new Nodal Officer – Finance to the TEQIP-III BOG

In the place of former Nodal Officer - Finance for TEQIP-III (*Dr. K Narasimha Chary, Sr. Professor in IP Engg., who retired from his services on 31-08-2020 on attaining the age of superannuation*) Dr. H V Ravindra, Principal & Director TEQIP-III suggested Dr. Anitha M L Professor in CS&E as a female representative. But, Honorable member Dr. H D Chowdaiah, suggested for having a male representative. Hence, the name of Dr. Vinay S, Professor and HoD of IS&E was considered for nomination as Nodal Officer - Finance for TEQIP-III for the remaining period of TEQIP-III i.e., till the end of March 2021.

4.7. Nomination of senior faculty member to the BOG of TEQIP-III

Resolved to approve the nomination of new member to the TEQIP-III BOG viz, Dr. R M Mahalinge Gowda, Professor in Civil Engg as member of the BOG in the place of Dr. K Narasimha Chary, Sr. Professor in IP Engg., who was serving as Member of the BOG & Nodal officer, Finance, TEQIP-III was also a member of the GC of our college as a faculty representative, who retired from services on 31-08-2020 on attaining the age of superannuation.

4.8. Mentor-Mentee Twinning activities.

Discussed and approved the Mentor-Mentee Twinning activities carried out virtually during Covid-19 Pandemic since March 2020 online.

Further, honorable, BoG member Dr. Tiwari, Prof. & HoD of UNSIET, VBSPU, Jaunpur thanked PESCE, Mandya and briefed about the Twinning activities including the conferences conducted.

4.9. FD's regarding Four funds & IRG

Resolved to approve the details of FD's under TEQIP-Phase-III



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Four Fixed Deposits have been created (amount deposited by the institution for four funds for TEQIP Phase III as per the guidelines of NPIU) in state Bank of India, KGL branch, Mandya.

The Internal Revenue generated (IRG) under TEQIP-III has been transferred to Institution's account and the same has also been kept as FDs at SBI, KGL branch, Mandya.

Further, Principal also mentioned that, more IRG amount shall be added and deposited to the Institutions account, provided additional grants are released to our institution under TEQIP-III.

4.10. Academic activities

a) Attaining ARIIA-2020 ranking for our Institution under MHRD.

The August body congratulated the Principal and his team in getting '2nd' place in category of 'Govt. and Govt. Aided Institutes & Colleges' in Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) 2020 announced on 18th Aug 2020 at national level.

b) Accreditation status.

The August body appreciated the accomplishment of the Institution in getting extension of accreditation (NBA) status to five under graduate courses up to 2023.

The Principal informed the august body that Two PG (M. Tech.) Programmes and MBA (optional) will be applied for accreditation by the end of TEQIP-III project period.

Dr. H D Chowdaiah, Former President, P.E.T ® expressed his concern about the closure of PG programmes due to very low admissions.

In order to boost the admission to the P.G Courses, Prof. D.K Subramanian and Dr. T V Ravi expressed their views to start integrated Programme (UG & PG) in consultation with VTU, Belagavi.

c) Sanction of project grants by AICTE, New Delhi under MODROBS

The August body congratulated and appreciated the Principal and his team of faculty in getting two AICTE, funded projects under MODROBS, worth about Rs. 24.00 lakhs from AICTE New Delhi during the month July 2020.



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Further, Principal informed the Honorable members that the project funding under NAIN & MSME, is under pipeline for the development of incubation center. Dr. Vinay S who is in charge of the project elaborated about the incubation center and informed that the Project funds will be utilized for further development after its release. The effort was very well appreciated and endorsed by BoG members, Prof. D K Subramanian and Dr. T V Ravi.

d) Innovative projects

The August body expressed its satisfaction for the efforts taken regarding showcasing innovative projects carried out by final semester students of UG/ PG programmes of the academic ear 2019-20, as done in the previous years. BoG member Prof. D K Subramanian told that he will evaluate the quality innovative projects for its recognition award.

Members also appreciated about Consultancy work being carried out at our Institute and bringing out the Brochure of the same. The august body expressed their view to improve the consultancy work of other Engineering Department.

e) Sanction of incentive for Research Book Publication by Dr. B. Dinesh Prabhu, Associate Professor in Automobile Engineering.

Members congratulated and appreciated Dr. B Dinesh Prabhu, Associate Professor in Automobile Engineering for publication of his book titled as "TRIBOLOGY" - Particulate Filled Polymeric Composite Materials – Investigations on Tribological properties for publication by an International Book publishing company based on his research work leading to Ph.D.

The same was also shown to the members virtually through online. Further, online teaching was also shown virtually to Dr. H D Chowdaiah at BoG meeting itself by Sri. K S Vijay Anand, Chairman,



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GC. Also, Sri. Vijay Anand interacted with one of the faculty members who were handling the class online and monitored the interaction with students virtually. Members appreciated the academic conduction of the same. Prof. D K Subramanian and Prof. N V Raghavendra very much appreciated the efforts and expressed their satisfaction about the method of online teaching being conducted and said it is innovative one.

Prof. Manohar G Nayak showed interest to know the utilization of 13 digital boards supplied to our institution by NPIU & MHRD. Dr. Vinay S. explained the utilization and limitations of the digital boards during our regular online teaching.
