Proceedings

The meeting was convened under the chairmanship of **Dr N L Murali Krishna**, Principal, PESCE, Mandya.

Agenda 1: Welcome address by Principal and Chairman IQAC

The Principal and Chairman of IQAC, welcomed both internal and external members of IQAC by introducing the new external members of academia and industry to the committee.

The coordinator of IQAC, Dr. Mahendra Babu K J briefed the committee members about the agenda of the meeting.

Agenda 2: Presentation of IQAC activities and findings of the academic audits & action (AAA) plan of AY 2024-25

Dr A C Kiran Kumar, Dy coordinator, IQAC, presented the key activities carried out by IQAC during AY 2024-25. The activities include AAA for 2023-24 conducted by external members and submission of action taken report by all department based on the AAA review.

He also presented brief report on major observations made by external audit team. The members of the committee discussed about the matter in detail and accepted the suggestions/ recommendations of the audit team and emphasized the need for departments to take necessary corrective actions. The Principal further expressed serious concern over the delay by certain departments in submitting their reports

Agenda 3: Review of Result analysis of AY 2024-25

Dr. D. R. Umesh, CoE, presented the result statistics along with the data on students eligible for graduation for the AY 2024–25. He also informed the members about the scheduled date for the Graduation Day. The members expressed serious concern regarding the number of ineligible students.

Agenda 4: Deliberation on student's performance in placements of AY 2024-25 and plan of action for improvement in AY 2025-26

Dr. Vinay S, Training & Placement Officer, presented the placement statistics for AY 2024–25. It was noted that, there has been a decline in the overall placement percentage compared to previous years. Discussions were held to evaluate the potential causes behind this drop. Dr. Vinay emphasized that one of the primary reasons could be the quality of students admitted and cited the possible global economic situation affecting recruitment trends across industries.

Mr. Naveen Kumar, an external member, expressed concern over the consistently poor performance of students in aptitude tests in recent years. He stressed the need for immediate remedial measures to improve student performance in this domain. Further, he highlighted the importance of developing communication skills and recommended the incorporation of language laboratories in the curriculum to strengthen students' proficiency in English.

Dr. D. K. Ramesh, another external member, recommended expanding outreach to core industries, particularly for non-circuit branches. He also stressed the importance of strengthening the alumni network and actively involving alumni in placement-related activities.

Dr. Vinay S, TPO, presented the various initiatives undertaken to enhance placement opportunities. He detailed the integration of skill development courses into the regular curriculum, with dedicated training slots from the 1st to the 7th semester. He also highlighted the noticeable improvement in student performance in international placements and outlined the strategic steps taken to achieve this progress. The committee members appreciated the proactive efforts of the Training and Placement Office and unanimously agreed to further enhance the placement activities. It was resolved to implement the suggestions put forth by the committee members to drive continuous improvement.

Agenda 5: Review of Research activities of AY 2024-25 and plan of action for AY 2025-26

Dean (Research), **Dr. Mahesh Koti**, presented an overview of the activities carried out by the Research Centre and briefed the committee on the newly framed Research Regulations. He also highlighted the introduction of a **Seed Money Grant** and an **Incentive Scheme** aimed at encouraging and strengthening research activities within the institution from AY 2025-26. In addition, he presented a new performance appraisal format for both teaching and technical staff, designed to evaluate the quality aspects of individual faculty on an annual basis.

Mr M. Subramanyam suggested to include quality parameters in the reports so as to assess the quality in placement, student's results, research and SDP

The committee members appreciated these initiatives, unanimously accepted the proposed regulations and resolved to implement them with effect from the AY 2025–26. It was also suggested that:

- Departments should actively encourage faculty members to apply for external funded projects.
- The Research Centre should organize regular workshops and training sessions on research methodology, proposal writing and intellectual property rights (IPR).

Agenda 6: Review of III activities of AY 2024-25 and plan of action for AY 2025-26

Dean (III), **Dr. Sadashiva M**, presented a comprehensive overview of the activities undertaken by the III Cell. He briefed the committee on the engagement of adjunct faculty members, signing of MoUs with reputed industries and various initiatives implemented to strengthen the industry–academia relationship. In addition, he highlighted efforts made towards enhancing internship opportunities, facilitating industry-driven projects, conducting expert lectures and workshops to bridge the gap between academic learning and industrial practices.

External member, Dr. D. K. Ramesh, suggested the need to explore collaborative research and consultancy to bridge academics along with industry collaboration.

Agenda 7: Review of NSS activities of AY 2024-25 and plan of action for AY 2025-26

Dr. Sunil Kumar N, NSS Officer presented a key activities carried out by NSS during AY 2024-25 The activities include the awareness on blood donation and HIV held by our students and the field visits to Govt. School at Chikkamandya, here the students of the school were educated about the basic hygiene and the campus was refurbished by the NSS team, PESCE, Mandya. Other activates namely Cleaning & Plantation of Pongamia pinnata in Bio-fuel Plant, Sadbhavana Karyakrama, and Constitution Day Celebration etc. were conducted by the NSS wing. The NSS officer also presented the activities charted down for the AY 2025-2026.

Agenda 8: Review of Students activities of AY 2024-25 and plan of action for AY 2025-26

Dr. Charan Kumar, SWO presented a key activities carried out by volunteers/students of PESCE during AY 2024-25. The activities organised and executed by the SWO are as follows.

The activities include Blood donation camp, Marathon by police dept. (awareness on drug addiction), Kannada Kalothsava, Nasha Mukth Bharath Abhiyan ect. The SWO was also informed to form various committees like dance, drama, music so on and so forth to create enthusiasm among culturally diversified students.

Agenda 9: Review of Sports activities of AY 2024-25 and plan of action for AY 2025-26

Dr. Anantha Prabhu, Physical Director, presented the summary of the activities conducted by the Sports Section during AY 2024–25. It was noted that students actively participated in various sports events at college, university, zonal, state and national levels, securing prizes in multiple categories.

He also informed the committee about the introduction of new NCC naval troop, established for the first time in the college. The external members appreciated the well-established sports facilities on the campus, which are also extended for use by the citizens of Mandya.

Agenda 10: Discussion on NBA accreditation of ECE and MCA departments

NBA Coordinator, **Dr. D. R. Umesh**, presented a report on the recent NBA accreditation visit for the ECE and MCA departments and updated the committee on NBA, NAAC accreditation and NIRF ranking. The members appreciated the institution's achievement of an 'A' grade in NAAC and securing a place in the 201–300 rank band in NIRF.

Agenda 11: Approval of proposed IQAC activities for AY 2025-26

Dr. Mahendra Babu K J presented the proposed activities of IQAC for AY 2025–26. The plan has been designed based on the gaps identified by the audit team during AY 2024–25 and includes the preparation of departmental activity calendars, formulation of the annual budget, promotion of innovative and best practices and the formation of DQAC. The proposed activities also cover Action taken report (ATR) based on previous semester results, FDP/SDP and workshops such as "AI for All". Additionally, FDP on morals, ethics and dress code, an SDP on entrepreneurship for students and the creation of various student clubs under SWO—including Music, Dance, Drama, Photography, Social Welfare, and Debating clubs—were outlined. The committee members appreciated the comprehensive plan and unanimously resolved to approve the proposed activities. In addition to the above activities the SDP (Strategic Development Plan) 2021-2026 was discussed in presence of SDP co-ordinator Dr. Poorna Prajna and the progress was not as expected, hence the committee proposed to achieve the key performance areas as per the time line of SDP.

The IQAC Coordinator expressed gratitude to all the members for their presence, active participation in the deliberations and for sharing their valuable suggestions. The Principal & Chairman then delivered the vote of thanks, seeking the continued support and cooperation of all IQAC Core Committee members and stakeholders in carrying forward the activities of IQAC.
